Neighborhood Assistance Program (NAP) Tax Credits offer you a wonderful opportunity to give to your favorite charity and get a direct income tax credit on your Indiana income tax return. A gift to an approved program results in a tax credit up to 50% of the amount of the gift up to a maximum tax credit of \$25,000 per taxpayer per year (\$50,000 charitable gift).
